Playhouse Concert Series Features Five Fantastic Bands

LAKE WORTH, Florida (December 18, 2009) – **SWING 8N'T ALL** kicks off the 2009-2010 Lake Worth Playhouse Concert Series on Thursday, December 31 at 8:00 p.m. The Concert Series returns for its third year at the Playhouse, bringing a diverse mix of sounds and styles that appeal to a variety of music tastes. SWING 8N'T ALL (December 31, 2009 – 8:00 p.m.)

The Playhouse New Year's Eve Celebration features **Swing 8n't All**, with special guest vocalist Roberta Rehner, performing popular favorites, including *Mack the Knife*, *Boogie Woogie Bugle Boy*, *Moonlight Serenade*, *My Way* and *New York, New York*. The evening includes hors d'oeuvres, party favors and a champagne toast.

THE LADS OF LIVERPOOL (January 27, 2010 – 8:00 p.m.)

The musical British Invasion was an influx of British bands from 1964-1967 who brought their songs to millions of listeners and fans from the United States and around the world. The 1960s were characterized by music of and for the times. **The Lads of Liverpool** play a tribute to the British bands of rock music that influenced a generation and dominated the airwaves and our memories ever since!

METROPOLITAN KLEZMER (February 18, 2010 – 8:00 p.m.)

Metropolitan Klezmer brings eclectic exuberance to Yiddish musical genres from all over the map. Performing vibrant versions of lesser-known gems from wedding dance,

trance, folk, swing and tango styles as well as soundtrack material from vintage Yiddish films, they reinvent tradition with both irreverence and respect for an exhilarating and unforgettable journey.

THE LATIN JAZZ PROJECT (March 10, 2010 – 8:00 p.m.)

The unique style of **The Latin Jazz Project** blends hot Latin-Jazz, Afro-Cuban and traditional Cuban instrumental music for a distinct sound that brings audiences to their feet. The nine-member band performs the music of Duke Ellington, Chucho Valdes and other Latin-Jazz greats.

THE LEGENDS OF DOO WOP (March 16, 2010 – 8:00 p.m.)

The Legends of Doo Wop are a well-known group harmony act that has played to standing-room-only audiences from New York to Los Angeles and throughout Europe performing popular favorites from the early days of Rock n' Roll. The band's members – Jimmy Gallagher (The Passions), Tony Marsa (The Crests), Frank Mancuso (The Imagination) and Steve Horn (The Five Sharks) – have four songs in the Top 100 Greatest Hits listing, recently released by WCBS radio in New York.
