**Lake Worth Playhouse Rings in 2011 with NEW YEAR'S SWING TIME,
the First in its Series of 2011 Concerts**

The Lake Worth Playhouse will ring in 2011 with **NEW YEAR'S SWING TIME: A New Year's Eve Celebration!** The evening includes live music, hors d'oeuvres, party favors and a champagne toast. The festivities begin at 8:00 p.m. at the Lake Worth Playhouse, located at 713 Lake Avenue in downtown Lake Worth.

The **NEW YEAR'S SWING TIME** concert features South Florida entertainer, Missy McArdle, backed by Glen Rovinelli's ten-piece orchestra, performing standard classics from the *American Songbook*. The concert includes music that spans the generations from World War II on, including favorites from Rosemary Clooney, and a selection of songs that will set the tone for a festive New Year's celebration.

An accomplished musician, Missy McArdle performs vocally and instrumentally throughout South Florida. She is a seven-time Carbonell Award nominee, recognized for her performances in *Cabaret*, *Fiddler on the Roof* and *A Moon for the Misbegotten* among others). She is recognized by music fans throughout South Florida as part of the esteemed musical trio (along with William Stafford and Mark Galsky) that conceived and performs the popular cabaret show, *From Berlin to Tin Pan Alley*. This internationally acclaimed group harmony act has played to standing-room-only audiences from New York to Los Angeles and throughout Europe performing popular favorites from the early days of Rock n' Roll.
