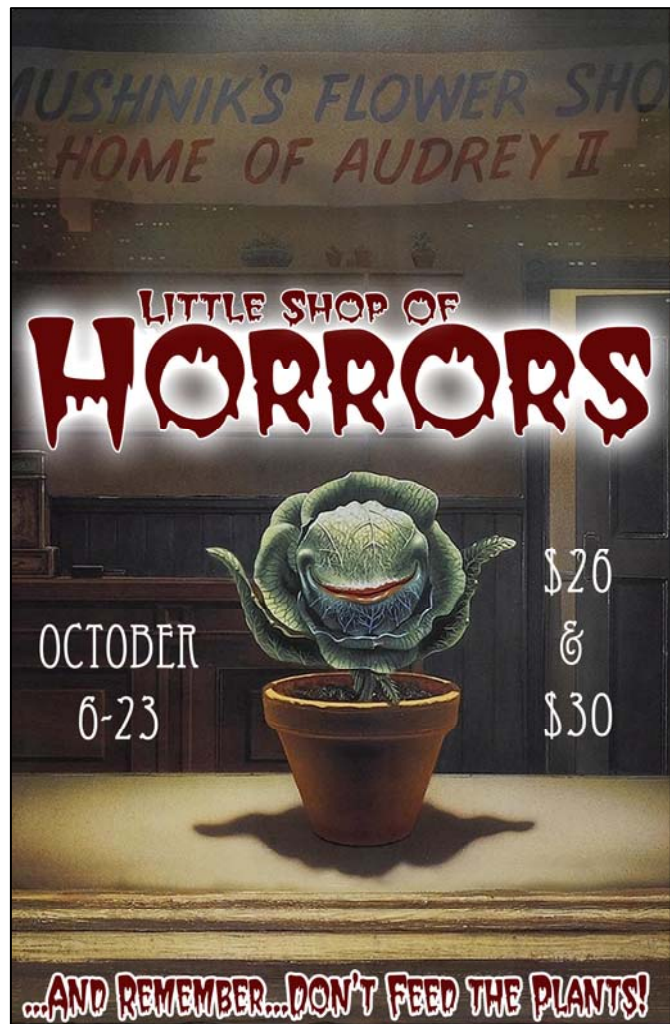
Synopsis:
