Lake Worth Playhouse CREATIVE STAGE classes teach kids the fundamentals of live musical theatre performance. Classes focus on the three disciplines of musical theatre performance: acting, stage movement and voice. Students learn through hands-on performance activities, including monologue work, scene study, musical numbers with choreography and songs related to live theatrical performances (not pop). Students will also learn basic theatrical terminology and stage directions, and build performance skills, such as voice projection, proper enunciation and projecting confidence in front of a crowd. Informances for parents are presented at the end of each class session to showcase students' new skills. (Musical Theatre I is for ages 9-12. Musical Theatre II is for ages 13 and up.)
